Directions from the airport to hotel

The nearest airport to the hotel is **Helsinki- Vantaa Airport (HEL)**. The airport is situated 18 kilometres outside the Helsinki city centre. Participants are advised to board the Finnair City Bus or the bus 615, both of which depart every 10 to 15 minutes outside the International Arrivals Terminal. A single ticket costs EUR 4,00 (bus 615, timetable <http://aikataulut.ytv.fi/linjat/en/s615.html>) or EUR 6,20 (Finnair, http://media.finnair.com/files/pdf/FINNAIR_CITY_BUS_TIMETABLE.pdf). The journey takes 35–40 minutes to the terminal.

If you prefer to take a taxi, the Yellow Line Airport Taxi (http://www.airporttaxi.fi/index_airporttaxi_en.html) costs EUR 27,00 (1–2 persons) and ordinary taxis about EUR 37,00 from the airport to the hotel. Please note that major credit cards are accepted. The journey takes approximately 30 minutes by taxi.

Directions from the hotels the conference venue (see map below)

The hotel **Klaus K** is within 15–20 minute walk from the conference venue (1.2 km). Leaving the hotel, cross the street Mannerheimintie, continue straight along the street Pohjois-Esplanadi by the park for 4 blocks, then turn left to Unioninkatu. Continue for 4 blocks (pass the square, the big white church and a small yellow church on your right), turn right to Rauhankatu, across the street and the Bank of Finland's Rauhankatu building is in front of you.
